

## 3 Week Intensive - "Boot Camp" - Airbrush Course - Auckland 2010.

• Airbrush Venturi is a private teaching organisation that specialises in teaching airbrushing. In Australia, it is the only registered airbrush school. It teaches the **Venturi Method. This is an advanced systematic method of airbrushing** that has taken over 20 years of research to develop. It has become the first ever nationally accredited airbrush course in Australia.

In Auckland, we have been offering this course since October 2004. The October 2010 course will be the 11th course we have run.

Tony Vowles, the founder of Airbrush Venturi, will be conducting the Auckland course. Being able to work with an airbrush artist with 25 years of full time airbrushing behind him in almost every application of the tool, should be seen as a great opportunity.

• This is not an "art" course, but a "rendering" course; how to render realist imagery with completely logical, systematic methods.

### **No prior "art" experience is required!**

We want to assure you that knowledge of other art tools does not relate to the airbrush.

In fact, people like tradesmen, etc, people who work with their hands, that are used to following systematic methods, learn the Venturi Method very quickly and easily.

• The intensive nature of the course puts all students under pressure and in turn causes frustration. It is very important that only people that have a strong motivation to learn the full Venturi Method attend, and that they come with an open mind and a determination to stick with the course, no matter how frustrated they become.

We want every course to be very successful. You don't need any prior art experience but you must come determined to make the course work for you personally.

Before you enrol, Tony Vowles will speak to you in person to make sure you understand the course and make sure the course is suitable for you. Please make contact by email or text.

**The up coming October course is going to be another huge event!**

You cannot elect to do just a week or two. We are only willing to teach a fully integrated course; to do less than the 3 weeks would mean attending an incomplete course.

The decision to offer courses in NZ is a direct result of PPG NZ. Without their support these courses would not be possible. As part of the 3rd week of the course we will also be teaching you to airbrush with PPG Deltron Basecoats, including Solids, Candies and Metallics, working on steel. PPG are willing to supply all of these paints free of charge for you, to use in the course. Normally you would only be taught to use water based inks on paper.

## The Custom Graphics Course - Auckland 2010.

In October 2005, we ran the first Custom Graphics Course in Auckland. Since then the courses have been very successful and popular. The students usually average 5 - 6 artwork panels in the CGC, but some students amazingly completed 11 steel panels in the 4 days.

Each course gets better and better. We have just developed a new course manual, with 70 pages just on the designing of flames that every custom painter would benefit from. We will even show you how to design flames on computer.

It will be a 4 Day - Double Weekend - Custom Graphics Course, and is ONLY open to past and present students. *"I am only wanting to work with people that already have established double action airbrush control skills, understand the Octave (so I can communicate effectively) and I know are serious about their airbrushing (because they gave up 3 weeks of their life to learn to airbrush)".*

We are also offering this course to those that are enrolled in the up coming 3 week course; after the first week, so they will have completed Unit A and have the required foundation of training and skills.

For those of you that attended previous courses, it will also be a great chance to revise the Method and show me what you have been working on.

For those attending the 3 week course at the same time, they will get a huge boost by increasing their time on the gun and consolidating their understanding of artwork structures and sequencing introduced in Unit A. It is also a much more relaxed and fun course, and will provide a welcome break to the intensity of the main course.

## Conditions of Acceptance of Your Enrolment in Our Courses

---

Due to an increasing range of problems relating to enrolment's in our courses, we find it necessary to ask that you accept a series of conditions that will help to ensure that everyone knows where they stand; that everyone understands their responsibilities to each other.

### **1. Form & Deposit = Enrolment:**

No position in any course will be reserved without an enrolment form AND a 25% (or greater) deposit. This includes repeat students coming back for advanced training. A new enrolment form MUST be completed for each and every course.

### **2. Confirming Your Enrolment:**

Please circle your preferred means of us confirming your enrolment. We will do our best to respond by these means. Because of the "grass roots" nature of our small organisation, with each teacher handling their own enrolment's, problems may occur.

People often don't fill in their enrolment form legibly, or are not available when we call and do not have an answering service for us to leave a message. It is very difficult to plan the time to continually call over a period of hours or days. There can be quite a number of different problems that can cause us to not be able to confirm your position.

If in the event that you have not been contacted by us within 7 days, please call the teacher you are working with, to ensure we have received your enrolment. We all have, both call waiting and message bank on all our phones, in the event that we miss your call, please leave a clear message.

### **3. Last Minute Withdrawals:**

Many of our courses completely book out. Although we often have people that are willing to "jump in" at the last minute, they are often deprived of the opportunity, because a person will pull out only days before we start and those waiting are not given enough notice.

Accordingly, if a student pulls out within seven days or less of the start of the course, we retain the right to not refund the deposit.

At our discretion, we are willing to transfer the deposit to a future course, depending on the circumstances. We will always try to be understanding and flexible, but only in direct proportion to the disruption to our school.

If more than seven days notice is given we will fully refund the deposit, or hold it for a future course, at your discretion.

### **4. Balance of Course Fees**

The balance of the course fees must be paid in full on the first day of the course unless prior arrangements are made with the teacher concerned.

### **5. We Supply Everything:**

All equip., materials and comprehensive notes are supplied. You are NOT allowed to bring anything other than your airbrush into the classroom without the teachers permission.
